Destination information

Slovenia, the green heart of Europe, lies between the mountainous Austria, Croatia and Italy, flat Hungary and the warm Adriatic Sea. Slovenia became an independent state in 1991 and has since gained a strong international profile and reputation as a democratic, stable and prosperous Central European country. Slovenia is a member of the United Nations, the European Union, the Eurozone, the Schengen Area, the OSCE, the OECD, the Council of Europe, and NATO.

Slovenia's variety and beauty surprise visitors from all over the world. Snowy Alpine peaks and the Triglav National Park with numerous glacial valleys, gorges, waterfalls, lakes, and crystal-clear whitewater invite visitors looking for peace in the mountains, as well as sports climbers, skiers, canoeists, and gliders in search for relaxation and excitement. Only a two hours' drive separates mountain enthusiasts from the pleasures offered by the Slovenian Mediterranean. A great deal of entertainment and the exquisite Primorska cuisine with fish specialities and top-quality wines satisfy even the most discerning tastes. The Karst region with its caves, plateaus, fields, disappearing streams, and intermittent lakes offers many possibilities for exploring and discovering Slovenia. There are many underground caves, from the world-famous Postojna Cave with beautiful stalactites, columns and draperies and UNESCO protected Škocjan Caves to grottos that are difficult to access, where climbing is only possible with experienced local guides. In Lipica (Karst), sheltered by century-old lime trees, there is an over 400-year-old stud farm of Lipizzaners, the famous white horses of Slovenian origin. Numerous natural spas developed near thermal and mineral springs. The Slovenian identity has developed together with a rich cultural life. It is mirrored in village and city architecture, numerous folk customs, cultural events, museums, and galleries. It is a country with an exceptional number of top athletes.

Maribor, whose origins as a town can be traced back to the 13th century, is today the second largest city of Slovenia and represents the centre of the Slovenian Štajerska region. The city's character has been shaped by its industry, which once played a significant role in the Slovenian economy. Apart from that, Maribor offers a rich and diverse cultural experience to residents and visitors alike. The renowned Slovenian National Theatre Maribor showcases drama, opera, and ballet performances, while several museums and galleries host numerous cultural events.

In 2012, Maribor was the European Capital of Culture. In addition to a wide range of cultural events, the city provides its citizens with beautiful and relaxing surroundings as it lies at the foothills of the Pohorje mountains, offering opportunities for diverse outdoor activities such as hiking and skiing. Special events like the traditional Golden Fox Trophy, a Women's Ski World Cup competition, as well as the international multicultural Festival Lent and events centred around the Old Vine, contribute to the vibrant atmosphere of the city.

Maribor is also known for its excellent wines, as the city is surrounded by numerous vineyards. Moreover, Maribor is a city with a prominent intellectual potential due to its University. It is home to the second largest university in Slovenia and recognises the importance of education for its development. All these features make Maribor an appealing and enjoyable destination for visitors from both Slovenia and abroad. Maribor ranked third on the list of top European destinations to visit in 2023 and was also named the best culinary destination in Europe.

Sport holds a significant place in Maribor. In 2018, Maribor was named a European City of Sport. The European Youth Olympic Festival is without a doubt the largest sporting event organised in Slovenia's modern history.

Customs and visas

The Republic of Slovenia is a member of the Schengen Area, where the free movement of persons, goods, services, and capital applies. As EU citizens, you need to have a valid passport or identity card to enter Slovenia. Children and minors must also have their own passport or identity card.

Please see the entry requirements provided on the respective official website of the Slovenian Embassy.

The below-mentioned participating countries must apply for a travel visa to enter Slovenia: Republic of Armenia, Republic of Azerbaijan, Republic of Belarus, Republic of Kosovo, and Republic of Türkiye.

Quality of drinking water

Slovenia is one of the most water-rich countries in Europe and takes prides in having drinking water of exceptional quality. They say that being able to pour clean water directly from the tap is a luxury today, and Slovenia offers this luxury to all its visitors at every step of the way. In Slovenia, visitors can quench their thirst by drinking water straight from the tap or from the water fountains in the cities. Water fountains are installed across Maribor as well.

Medical and health services

All accredited groups participating in the EYOF Maribor 2023 are insured by the Organising Committee.

During the European Youth Olympic Festival, the Maribor University Medical Centre will be open 24/7 and medical assistance will be provided daily through the Dr Adolf Drolc Health Centre.

Arrivals and departures

Arrivals by plane or train

EOC Family and guests will be provided transport from the official points of entry to the accommodation and back. They may share a ride with other EOC Family Guests. The waiting time after arrival is estimated not to be longer than 30 minutes. Transport arrangements will be based on the provided information.

Transport from Vienna airport can be arranged for an extra fee (one-way fee € 300).

Arrivals and departures by car/bus

Participants arriving by their own means of transportation are advised to note the requirement to pay tolls for personal vehicles and buses on Slovenian motorways. Vignettes for motorways in the Republic of Slovenia are in electronic form and can be purchased from E-vinjeta at https://evinjeta.dars.si/en.

Upon your arrival to Maribor, please visit the EOC Family Welcome and Information Desk in Habakuk Hotel to collect your accreditation.

Guests arriving by car are advised to park their vehicles at either Habakuk Hotel or Hotel Arena, depending on where you are accommodated. Parking at both hotels is free of charge for the guests.

During the event, the EOC Family guests will be provided with free transportation. We recommend using the transportation services available to accredited guests, as outlined below.



Transport within Maribor

The Organising Committee will arrange transportation of the EOC Family guests and their accompanying guests to and from the Opening and Closing Ceremonies and to the locations of events scheduled within the special programme

by dedicated buses.

Transportation for the EOC Family will be categorised into three groups: T1, T2, T3, according to their assigned trans-

port privileges.

For all accredited persons there is free public transportation within Maribor and EYOF bus lines which connect the

EOC Family hotel with the sports venues.

T1/T2

T1 transport service includes dedicated car with a driver and the T2 transport service includes dedicated car without

a driver.

T3

T3 transport service includes a car on-demand. It can be booked upon request at the EOC Family Transport Desk the

day before the required service. Transport is available between 7:00 and 22:00.

T3 pick-up and drop-off points include EOC Family Hotel Habakuk, all competition venues, Main Media Center (MMC)

and athletes' dormitories.

In order to use this service, the T3 entitled members should make a reservation as soon as possible and at the latest

by 22:00 the day before the T3 service is needed. The availability of the car on-demand service will depend on

the final number of cars that the Organising Committee will have at its disposal.

EOC Family members' accompanying guests can use the vehicle if they are accompanying a person who is T3-ac-

credited. Accompanying guests are not accredited to use T3 transport on their own. They are welcome to use public

transportation and EYOF bus lines.



EYOF bus lines

Bus schedules will be available at every bus stop, accessible via QR code, and on the EYOF 2023 Maribor website. A Transport Guide with maps of all EYOF bus lines will be available upon arrival to the EYOF. All schedules for all lines will be available at the Transport Info Desk at the EOC Family Hotel Habakuk. The buses will operate on a circular route in two opposite directions, departing every 10 minutes while during rush hours the frequency will increase to every 5 minutes. Timetables will be published closer to the event at www.eyof-maribor.com/en/transport.

Pohorje cable car

Pohorje cable car offers a special adventure with breathtaking views for guests. It will run every 30 minutes during the day, transporting participants to Pohorje village where the volleyball teams will be accommodated. The cable car will run between 6:30 and 23:30. Access will be granted with the accreditation card.

Accreditation

The official registration and accreditation process for all accredited guests attending the event will be conducted through the EOC Games Management System (GMS). The deadline for registration for EOC Family is 26 June 2023.

EOC Family accreditations will be distributed at the Accreditation Desk located at the EOC Family Welcome and Information Desk – the main point of contact for EOC Family accredited members.





Opening Ceremony

The EYOF Opening Ceremony will take place on Sunday, 23 July 2023 at 20:30, at the Ljudski vrt Stadium. The stadium is the third largest in Slovenia and there are over 7,000 seats available for the ceremony. Accredited guests will be able to enter with their accreditation. The event will also be open to the public. Free tickets will be available.

The Opening Ceremony will be broadcast live on national TV, with a live pre-studio show starting at 20:00.

Closing Ceremony

Medal ceremonies

The goal of the medal ceremony is to honour the athletes who have won a medal, to promote the spirit of Olympism and sportsmanship, and to ensure that the athletes have an unforgettable moment. The ceremonies follow the EOC protocol and the Summer EYOF Ceremonies Guidelines. Medal ceremonies will take place at each sport venue in accordance with the competition and awards schedule for each sport and discipline.

There will always be two presenters at each medal ceremony: one medal presenter and one mascot presenter. More than one presenter may be appointed to present the medals and mascots in team sports.

Medals will be awarded by EOC EC members, NOC Presidents and Secretaries General or any other international sports representatives as appointed by the EOC.

Mascots will be awarded by representatives of the European Sports Federations and local representatives from sport, political and public authorities.

The medal/mascot presenters will receive an official invitation, including all the necessary details for their participation in the medal ceremony. Medal/Mascot presenters must confirm their participation to the Protocol Team within the specified time and in the way requested in the invitation. Once confirmed, the medal/mascot presenters will receive the Medal Ceremonies Presenters Guidelines with more detailed information.

Transportation for medal/mascot presenters will be arranged by the Organising Committee.

Medal/Mascot presenters must be accredited to access the medal ceremony area and identify themselves upon arrival in the designated protocol room or preparation area.
